November 3rd, 2020

In accordance with the warrant, the inhabitants of Brewster, qualified to vote in the **State Election** met at the Brewster Baptist Church, 1848 Main Street, Brewster, on **Tuesday, November 3rd, 2020**.

The Covid-19 Pandemic led to the enactment of Chapter 115 of the Acts of 2020 calling for 14 days of In-person early voting along with a vote-by-mail option. The Town of Brewster mailed out 4429 early vote-by-mail ballots, along with 384 absentee ballots. 3599 of these ballots were returned by mail, the rest chose to vote in person after receiving a vote-by-mail ballot, requiring the vote-by-mail ballot to be canceled.

From October 17th through October 30th Early Voting In-person was offered in the lower level of Town Hall. The daily voter turnouts are listed below, some individuals who had requested a vote-by-mail ballot chose to cancel that ballot and vote in-person during this early voting period.


